PURPOSE

The purpose of this item is to receive citizens' comments regarding a petition for the voluntary annexation from the University of North Carolina for a portion of their property located off of University Lake Road proposed for a park and ride lot.

INFORMATION:

Nancy D. Suttentfield, Vice Chancellor for Finance and Administration, submitted a petition for annexation dated August 22, 2001. The petition requests that 7.73 acres located South of Old Fayetteville Road (SR 1937) and East of University Lake Road (SR 1005) be annexed into the Town. The area to be annexed is contiguous to the Town's municipal boundary and is referenced as being a portion of Tax Map 7.116..10. The acreage proposed for annexation is only a small portion of the entire 574.34 University Lake property and is located outside of the University Lake Watershed.

This public hearing is being held in reference to the Board of Aldermen's September 11, 2001 acceptance of the petition for annexation and adoption of a resolution setting the public hearing.

ACTION REQUESTED:

The Board of Aldermen is requested to hold a public hearing to receive public comment regarding the Petition for Annexation and to consider the Petition for Annexation as submitted by Nancy D. Suttentfield, Vice Chancellor for Finance and Administration, University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill.

ADMINISTRATION'S RECOMMENDATION:

The administration recommends that the Board of Aldermen adopt the attached ordinance that annexes the 7.73 acres located South of Old Fayetteville Road (SR 1937) and East of University Lake Road (SR 1005), into the Town of Carrboro effective October 31, 2001.
