AN ORDINANCE AMENDING FY'2001-02 BUDGET ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Carrboro on June 26, 2001 adopted the annual budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2001 and ending June 30, 2002; and
