PURPOSE

The Chapel Hill-Carrboro Chamber of Commerce spearheaded a fundraising project to purchase and install two exterior clocks for the Carrboro Century Center tower. The Chamber of Commerce has received \$12,176 in donations. The Board is requested to adopt a resolution of appreciation thanking businesses and community residents and friends for their contributions. In addition, a budget amendment is requested to acknowledge the donations and to appropriate the funds for the purchase of the clocks.

INFORMATION

Donations were received from businesses and citizens throughout our community in the amount of \$12,176. The businesses and citizens who donated money will be recognized on two plaques (one plaque will be located on the interior of the Century Center, and the other will be located on the exterior).

A budget amendment is also required to appropriate the donations for the purchase of the clocks.

ADMINISTRATION'S RECOMMENDATION

The administration recommends that the businesses and citizens be officially recognized through the process of "A Resolution of Appreciation" and that the Board of Aldermen adopt the budget ordinance enabling the purchase of the clocks.
