WHEREAS, Mr. Gordon Cook has applied for a seat; and

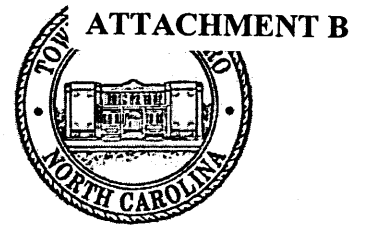
WHEREAS, Mr. Cook's application was reviewed by the Chair of the Recreation and Parks Commission is recommending Mr. Cook's appointment.
