### PURPOSE

On August 27, 2002 the Mayor and Board of Aldermen received a request from Mr. Ted Bleeker to re-evaluate the decision to place a traffic signal on his property located on East Main Street. The town staff has prepared a report on this matter for the Board's review. The administration requests adoption of the attached resolution approving Option 1 for the installation of a traffic/pedestrian crosswalk signal at the East Main/Rosemary Street intersection.

### INFORMATION

At the August 27<sup>th</sup> Board meeting Mr. Bleeker also expressed concern that the placement of the traffic signal on his property would prohibit him from providing a 16-foot handicapped parking space on his property. The Chief Building Inspector has reviewed this and has determined that Mr. Bleeker's plans complied with the handicap requirements of the building code at the time the permit was issued and he is not required to meet current requirements.

### ADMINISTRATION'S RECOMMENDATION

The administration recommends adoption of the attached resolution approving Option 1 for the installation of a traffic/pedestrian crosswalk signal at the intersection of East Main and Rosemary Streets.
