<u>PUBLIC HEARING: A REQUEST TO ADOPT A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF</u> THE 2002 LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT BLOCK GRANT

The Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) has notified the Carrboro Police Department of approval of a Year 2002 Local Law Enforcement Block Grant (LLEBG). This grant is for \$18,179 and requires a match of \$2,020 from the Town of Carrboro. WHEREAS, the Carrboro Board of Aldermen has accepted the Local Law Enforcement Block Grant every year since 1997; and
