**PURPOSE**

The Town of Carrboro’s Residential Traffic Management Plan provides an opportunity for residents to petition for traffic calming measures on neighborhood streets. At its May 20, 2003 meeting, the Board of Aldermen requested that an amendment be prepared to the RTMP to require that residents provide 50 percent of the construction cost of traffic calming devices. A resolution has been prepared for the Board’s adoption.

**INFORMATION**

Town staff recommends that the Board of Aldermen change to the Residential Traffic Management Program to require that 50 percent of the construction cost of traffic calming devices.

This requirement could be waived by the Board of Aldermen if the median assessed value of dwelling units on properties adjacent to the applicable street segment does not exceed the price of an affordable housing unit as determined by Section 15-182.4 (a) of the Carrboro Land Use Ordinance (Attachment C).

**RECOMMENDATION**

The Administration recommends that the Board of Aldermen adopt the ordinance amending the Residential Traffic Management Plan (Attachment A).
