**PURPOSE**

On March 21, the Triangle J Council of Governments announced that it has launched an effort to develop a plan for consolidating local and regional transit systems in the Triangle. Mr. Sanford Cross, Project Consultant, and other members of the consultant team will make a presentation to the Board of Aldermen on the consolidation plan. A resolution has been prepared for the Board’s adoption.

**INFORMATION**
