### PURPOSE

The Durham-Chapel Hill-Carrboro Metropolitan Planning Organization has initiated the preparation of the 2006-2012 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). At the beginning of this process, local governments are requested to provide a local priority list of projects. The public hearing on this matter allows the Board to receive citizen comments on the local priority list. A resolution that adopts the local priority list is recommended for the Board's adoption. (Attachment A).

### INFORMATION

The TIP includes cost estimates and funding schedules for highway, bicycle, pedestrian, rail, public transit, and aviation projects over a seven year period. The TIP is updated every other year. The schedule for preparing the 2006-2012 TIP specifies that local governments finalize their project lists during October.

Carrboro's local priority list will be forwarded to the Technical Coordinating Committee (TCC) of the Durham-Chapel Hill-Carrboro Metropolitan Planning Organization (DCHC MPO). The projects from all local governments within the MPO will be compiled and prioritized into a regional priority list in early 2004.

The Transportation Advisory Board began discussion of the local priority list in September and concluded this review on October 2 (Attachment C). In addition to the projects on the TAB list, the Board may wish to consider other projects, including those on Attachment D.

As a reference, the 2004-2010 Durham-Chapel Hill-Carrboro MPO TIP is enclosed (Attachment E).

## **RECOMMENDATION**

The Administration recommends that the Board of Aldermen adopt the attached resolution that specifies the projects to be included on the local priority list for the 2006-2012 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP).
