### PURPOSE

On June 15, 2004, the Board of Aldermen approved creation of a committee to review rezoning possibilities at the interface between residential and commercial zones in downtown Carrboro. Two applications have been received for citizen members. A resolution that establishes the charge for this subcommittee and appoints its members has been prepared.

### INFORMATION

A process to review draft ordinances establishing two new commercial-residential interface zones and make recommendations regarding placement was approved on June 15<sup>th</sup>. A resolution that would establish the subcommittee charge and make appointments is attached (*Attachment A*). The Board of Aldermen, Planning Board and Downtown Development Commission have identified representatives who are interested in serving on this subcommittee. The names of these individuals are included in the attached resolution.

Michelle Rivest and Blan Holman submitted applications (*Attachment B*) to the town requesting consideration for appointments as citizen members of the subcommittee. .
