Process and Schedule for Reviewing Carolina North Plans: The Committee members present reviewed the Council's charge of May 24, 2004 to compare the Principles, Goals and Strategies to the Carolina North Plan. The Committee members decided to use the subcommittee structure to begin the Committee's comparison. The members agreed to a schedule that would result in a report to the Town Council on October 11, 2004. The subcommittees will meet in July and August, and present their work at the next full Committee meeting scheduled for August 19. The Committee would then have up to three work sessions to develop its recommendation to the Council, meeting on September 2, 16, and 30th if needed.

Vacancy on Committee: The Committee members decided to ask the Council to select a new member to replace Blair Pollack, following his resignation, on June 30 so that a new member could participate in the subcommittee discussions over the summer. In addition, the Committee members asked the Chair to inquire about the status of replacing the Carrboro appointee to the Committee David Otto, who resigned this spring. The Committee members asked the Chair to inquire of Kathleen Kearns whether she would be willing to serve again (subsequently the Chair determined she was not). In addition, Committee members suggested recommending Rudy Juliano.
