PURPOSE

The Board of Aldermen is requested to adopt a resolution establishing a monument in honor of Catherine Peele.

INFORMATION

At the June 7, 2005 Board of Alderman meeting, Jay Bryan asked about his request for the Town to declare a "Catherine Peele Day" in Carrboro, plant a tree on Town Hall grounds, and install a plaque to honor her service to the Town. Mayor Pro Tem McDuffee requested that staff contact Stanley Peele prior to the Board taking action. Mr. Bryan informed staff that Mr. Peele approved the idea. A resolution to approve this request is provided (Attachment A).

FISCAL IMPACT

There will be expenses associated with the purchase of the tree and plaque. No funds have been budgeted for this purpose.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the Board of Aldermen approve the resolution to establish a monument to honor Catherine Peele.
