AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CARRBORO LAND USE ORDINANCE WITH REGARD TO LAND USE PERMIT REQUIREMENTS FOR TOWN-OWNED AND OPERATED FACILITIES AND SERVICES

THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF CARRBORO ORDAINS:

Section 1. Article IV, Section 15-64 of the Carrboro Land Use Ordinance is amended by adding thereto a new subsection (h) to read as follows:

- (h) Notwithstanding the other provisions of this section, whenever town-owned facilities or services are proposed as an additional use on property for which a special use permit or a conditional use permit is already in effect the permit required by this article for the new town-owned facility or service shall be as shown in Section 15-146.
- Section 2. All provisions of any town ordinance in conflict with this ordinance are repealed.
- Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.
