

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR AND TOWN CLERK TO SIGN AND
EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NCDOT FOR PROJECT C-4931 FOR THE
PROVISION OF SHARED RIDE SERVICES IN CARRBORO

Resolution No. 77/2005-06

WHEREAS, the Municipality has requested CMAQ funding in order that Chapel Hill Transit may provide shared rider feeder service to areas not receiving regular bus service in Carrboro, Orange County, North Carolina; and,

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation has programmed funding in the 2006-2012 Transportation Improvement Program, as revised, for said bus service under Project C-4931, Orange County; and,

WHEREAS, the Municipality proposes to enter into an Agreement with the North Carolina Department of Transportation for said bus service as described in said Agreement; and,

WHEREAS, under the proposed Agreement and subject to the Agreement provisions, the Department shall reimburse the Municipality to the extent of fifty percent (50%) of the approved eligible costs up to the maximum federal award amount of \$39,020. The funding for this project is as follows:

Implement FFY '06 - \$ 12,500 (CMAQ)	
Implement FFY '06 - \$ 12,500 (Local Match)	
Implement FFY '07 - \$ 13,000 (CMAQ)	
Implement FFY '07 - \$ 13,000 (Local Match)	
Implement FFY '08 - \$ 13,520 (CMAQ)	
Implement FFY '08 - \$ 13,520 (Local Match)	
Total Cost	\$78,040 (CMAQ/Local Match); and,

WHEREAS, the Municipality shall ensure that at least fifty percent (50%) matching funds are provided as well as all costs that exceed the federal award amount of \$39,020.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Agreement for Project C-4931 in Orange County is hereby formally approved by the Board of Aldermen of the Town of Carrboro and that the Mayor and Clerk of this Municipality are hereby empowered to sign and execute this Agreement between the Municipality and the Department of Transportation.

Shared Ride Transit Services To Be Provided in 2006
(This is the information that has been posted on the Town of Carrboro Website)

The Town of Carrboro is working with Chapel Hill Transit to provide Shared Ride on-demand transit services to areas of Carrboro that do not have fixed-route bus service. It is anticipated that these services will begin in March 2006.

Two types of Shared Ride services will be provided in Carrboro, Feeder Service and Evening/Sunday Service.

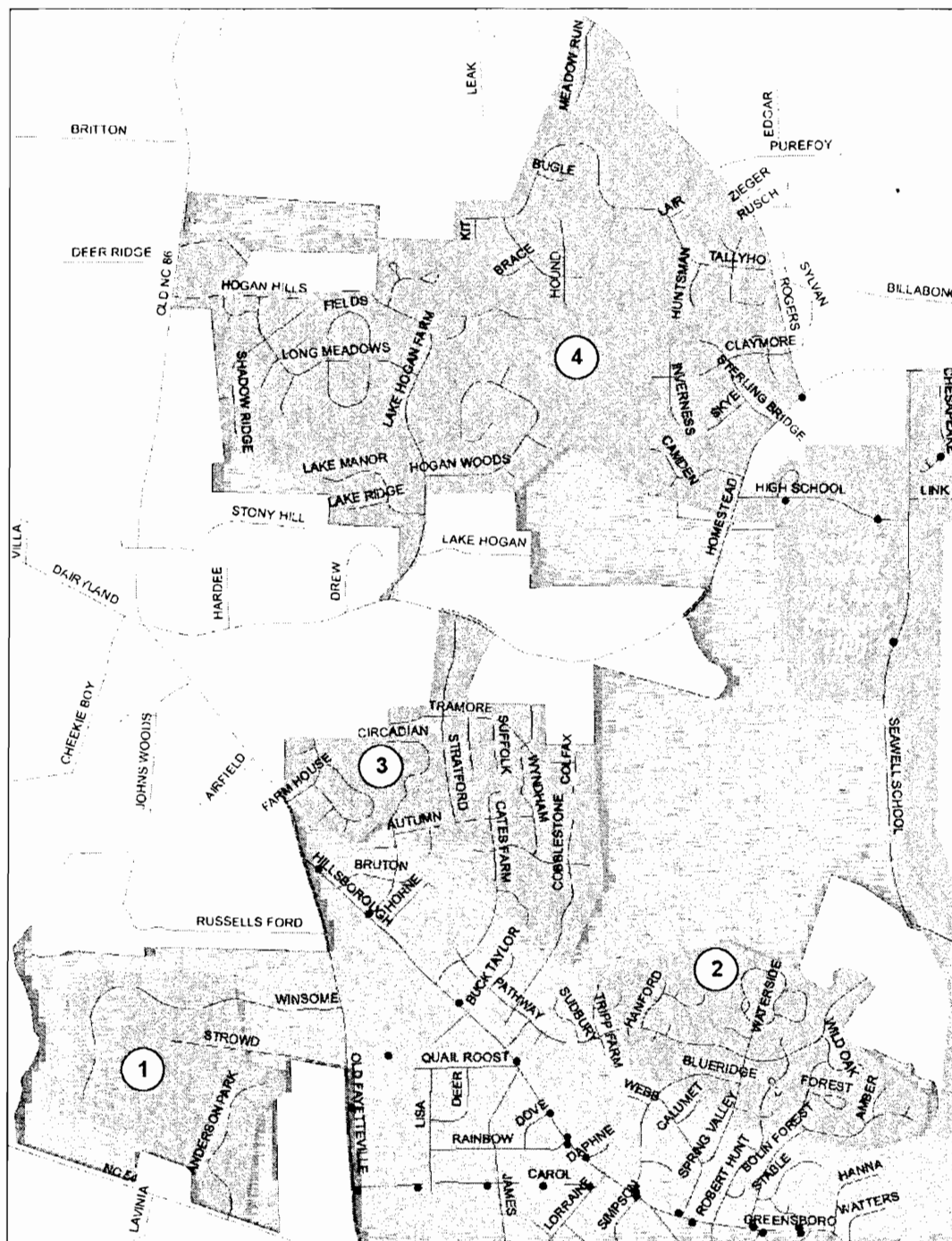
- Feeder Service, which is provided at no charge between 6:45 am and 6:15 pm on weekdays, provides trips between designated bus stops in the “feeder” zones and the nearest bus route or to another “feeder” zone.
- Evening/Sunday Service is provided to areas that do not have regular evening, Saturday, and Sunday bus service and requires that users pay with Chapel Hill Transit bus tickets (tickets can be purchased at Carrboro Town Hall and other locations).

Funding for the enhanced transit services are being provided through federal Congestion Mitigation / Air Quality (CMAQ) funds and a 50 percent local match included in the 2005-2006 Town of Carrboro budget.

The attached map shows the areas where the Shared Ride Feeder Service will be provided (generally areas that are more than a quarter mile from a fixed-route transit route).

Information about how to request Shared Ride services has been included in the Chapel Hill Transit Route Guide that was released in January 2006. Additional information will be made available to let residents know the beginning date for the Shared Ride services in Carrboro.
