# A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSING OF STREETS TO ACCOMMODATE THE POWERMAN NORTH CAROLINA DUATHLON Resolution No. 74/2005-06

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the Town of Carrboro that the following streets are allowed to be temporarily blocked or subject to slowed traffic between 8 am -12:30 pm on Sunday, April 23, 2006 to accommodate the Powerman North Carolina Duathlon. This event is to be held in accordance with the permit issued by the Board of Aldermen pursuant to Article III of Chapter 7 of the Town Code.

- Hillsborough Road (between McDougle School service Road and Lorraine) (bike lane only). Runners make a right turn onto Lorraine.
- Lorraine St. between Hillsborough and James St.. Runners make a right turn and proceed north on James St.
- James Street between Lorraine and Quail Roost. Runners make a left turn onto Quail Roost and re-enter the McDougle School grounds.
- Upon starting the bicycle part of the race, racers exit McDougle School onto Old Fayetteville Rd. and proceed north through the light and into Orange County (where Orange County Sheriff's deputies take over traffic control.

The Town shall supply the appropriate traffic control devices to give notice of the temporary traffic controls.

The Event Coordinator will be responsible for notifying Central Communications when the street is closed and when it is reopened to vehicular traffic.

This resolution shall become effective upon adoption.

#### **NOTIFICATION OF CENTRAL COMMUNICATIONS (911):**

The APPLICANT is responsible for notifying Central Communications (911):

- at least five (5) days in advance of the event in writing (Orange County EMS, Post Office Box 8181. Hillsborough, NC 27278)
- on the day of the closing, prior to the actual closing of the street (dialing 911)
- on the day of the closing, when the street is re-opened (dialing 911)

#### **NOTIFICATION OF THE PUBLIC:**

A public hearing is required for all street closing permit applications and the applicant must speak with the Town Clerk about requesting this public hearing. The public must be notified by a formal advertisement in a local newspaper. The Public Works Department will submit the advertisement copy to the newspaper. However, the applicant will be responsible for reimbursing the Town for the full cost of the advertisement (an estimated \$30-\$40).

Any other notification of the public of this event will be the Applicant's responsibility.

#### NOTIFICATION OF ABUTTING PROPERTY OWNERS:

The APPLICANT is responsible for notifying all abutting property owners of the Public Hearing. Such notification must be accomplished at least seven days prior to the Public Hearing. The notification must include:

- the DATE, TIME and LOCATION of the proposed street closing; and
- the DATE, TIME and LOCATION of the Public Hearing as well as the subject matter of this Public Hearing

The Public Works Department must receive in writing from the APPLICANT the following at least five days prior to the Public Hearing:
