

**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING TWO POTENTIAL ROUTES FOR THE MOUNTAINS TO SEA
TRAIL IN ORANGE COUNTY
Resolution No. 78/2005-06**

WHEREAS, the Mountains to Sea Trail is planned to provide an exciting cross-state recreation and tourism resource for all North Carolinians; and

WHEREAS, the Trail is planned to cover nearly 1,000 miles of this state, when all spurs and side trails are included; and

WHEREAS, the Trail will highlight a wide variety of historic and natural resources across the state; and

WHEREAS, two potential trails through the Piedmont would include the proposed Riverwalk and travel through Hillsborough; and

WHEREAS, by including the Riverwalk, trail users would be able to visit Occoneechee State Natural Area, the highest point in Orange County with unique flora and fauna; and

WHEREAS, by including the Riverwalk, trail users would be able to visit Orange County with its rich heritage tourism program; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF
CARRBORO:**

Section 1. The Board of Aldermen recommends that the State and the Friends of the Mountains to Sea Trail select one of the two proposed routes that incorporate the Hillsborough Riverwalk to the benefit of all North Carolinians.

Section 2. This resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
