ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF CARRBORO:**

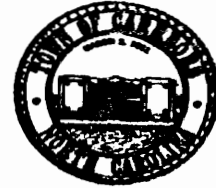

Mark:

My appointment to the Orange County Solid Waste Advisory Board has a Carrboro representative expires the end of this month. I'm interesting in serving an additional term as one "Carrboro representatives and request reappointment by the Board Aldermen. Your assistance in this matter is deeply appreciated.

A matter discuss at the Ten Year Solid Waste Plan Task Group Meeting concerning the possible use of Durham's Waste Transfer Station has some budgetary impacts on Carrboro that were not discussed in the meetings. I outline the concern below for the Alderman.s consideration.

The county when it closes the current landfill will need to find options for disposing of its waste. All of the options will involve disposal of its municipal waste outside of Orange County. Transportation costs will dictate the use of a transfer station for Chapel Hill, Carrboro's and Orange County Waste. The primary impact of the decision on the location of the landfill will be financial on Carrboro's costs of providing solid waste collection. Local solid waste collection vehicles are not designed for efficient use on highways. Transit time allocated to reaching a transfer station will impact the availability of the equipment and cost of operating the equipment based on a distance to the transfer station from the collection area. Selection of a transfer station with any significant increase in travel time to and from Carrboro will impact Carrboro's capital budget by requiring the purchase of significantly more trash trucks while decreasing the productivity of the public works staff. Use of Durham's transfer station will add at least an hour 1.5 hours to each garbage truck cycle. An informed consideration of additional travel time and the effect on the productivity of the public

works department should be a priority in considering the acceptability of the location for the transfer station. The Public Works Department should be able to provide estimates of the cost impacts based on travel time for Carrboro on any sites considered and the impact on capital needs and operating cost for Carrboro.
