AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 14 OF THE TOWN CODE TO PROHIBIT ADVERTISING OF EVENTS ON TOWN PROPERTY UNTIL SUCH PROPERTY HAS BEEN PROPERLY RESERVED AND TO PROVIDE FOR ADDITIONAL SANCTIONS FOR VIOLATION OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS CHAPTER

THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF CARRBORO ORDAINS:

- Section 1. Section 14-5 of the Carrboro Town code is amended by adding a new subsection (d) to read as follows:
- (d) No person may advertise in any manner or otherwise invite persons to attend any function or event on town property that is subject to a reservation system established pursuant to subsection (a) of this section unless and until the facility where such function or event is to take place has been properly reserved in accordance with such reservation system.
- Section 2. Section 14-29 of the Carrboro Town Code is amended by redesignating subsection (e) as subsection (f) and by adding a new subsection (e) to read as follows:
- (e) If a person or organization repeatedly violates any of the provisions of this chapter or any of the rules or policies applicable to the reservation or use of town property established under Section 14-28, the administrator may in writing prohibit such person or organization from reserving, using, or entering specified town properties for a period of up to two years.
- Section 3. Subsection 14-29 is further amended by revising the first sentence of subsection (b) to read: "A violation of any of the provisions of this chapter shall also subject the offender to a civil penalty of fifty dollars (\$50.00).
 - Section 4. All provisions of any town ordinance in conflict with this ordinance are repealed.
 - Section 5. This ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.
