#### **PURPOSE**

The purpose of this agenda item is to request that the Board to adopt a revised Chapter 12 (Fire Prevention and Protection) of the Town Code. The revised ordinance includes the updated State Fire Code and addresses enforcement issues regarding mulch piles.

#### **INFORMATION**

In July of 2006, the State of North Carolina adopted a new fire code. The state allows for up to six months to use the old fire code or the newly adopted fire code. The Town Code needed to be updated to recognize this aspect. Also, additional language has been added to the town code to help with enforcement issues regarding mulch piles. This language mandates that the fire department would have to issue a permit for large mulch piles and provide access for fire trucks to adequately abate the hazard. This ordinance will also mandate 36 new operational permits that are not presently required to help assist enforcement powers with other special hazards throughout the town.
