PURPOSE

During a March 14, 2006 worksession to discuss the adopted Capital Improvements Program: FY 2006-2007 through FY 2011-2012, the Board of Aldermen requested an opportunity to discuss the master plan and an alternative design for the Martin Luther King, Jr. Park.
