PURPOSE

Preparation of a long-range transit plan for Chapel Hill Transit has been long anticipated. A \$522,000 planning process has been developed and funding commitments have been obtained from the transit partners and the Durham-Chapel Hill-Carrboro Metropolitan Planning Organization. A resolution that authorizes the Town Manager to sign a Memorandum of Agreement that specifies Carrboro’s participation in the project has been prepared and is recommended for the Board’s adoption.

FISCAL IMPACT

Carrboro’s share of the matching funds for the long range transit plan is \$45,308. Staff time for project coordination and administration would also be involved. Matching funds have been included in the transportation budget for the current fiscal year.

The staff recommends that the Board of Aldermen adopt the attached resolution (*Attachment A*) authorizing the manager to sign the MOA and forward to Chapel Hill for final signatures.
