Sharon Cook is a Homemaker with 3 children. She has been living 10 years in the northeast part of Carrboro that was annexed last year. She has been very actively involved in transportation & walkability issues for the Rogers Road/Homestead Road area where she lives. During and after the annexation she has spoken frequently on a number of issues facing Carrboro's newest residents. I think she has a detailed knowledge of development patterns that will best suit Carrboro and be sensitive to the Town's history and natural environment.

How applicant compliments current board composition:

I met with Sharon for well over an hour and was very impressed by both her enthusiasm for working on town issues and the depth of her knowledge of what makes the built environment walkable, "transit-oriented," and environmentally sustainable. She grew up and spent much of her adult life prior to moving to Carrboro in mid-western communities with traditional street "grids" of fairly dense residential neighborhoods that had shopping and schools within easy walking or biking distance. Sharon is keenly aware of the lack of commercial services in the northern part of Carrboro, an issue that is in the forefront of topics Carrboro citizens have expressed interest in addressing. As a resident of that part of town, and in light of her generous approach to public service, I think she will be a great resource for the Planning Board and for the Town.

Other comments:

Last year I recommended two residents of the newly annexed part of Carrboro for Planning Board seats, Mary Rabinowitz and Lydia Lavelle. I feel that this somewhat heavy representation from this part of town is an important way to accelerate the involvement of the new citizens and to become aware of their interests and concerns. Subsequent to her appointment, Mary Rabinowitz moved to a neighborhood close to the town center. For this reason, I want to seat another "New Northeast" resident on the Planning Board.

In the end, we all felt that Daniel should remain on the board, and voted to recommend him for reappointment (vote was 5-0, with 2 absent)


