### PURPOSE

The Town of Carrboro has identified various items of surplus property and would like to sell the surplus personal property at an auction. Prior to disposing the items, NC General Statute 160A-270 requires that the Board approve a resolution to declare the property as surplus and authorize the sale of these items.

### INFORMATION

Article VIII Section 3-39 (a) (1) of the Town Code authorizes the Town Manager to dispose of surplus property with a fair market value of less than \$30,000. The attached list of items has a fair market value of over \$30,000 and therefore requires Board approval.

Included are several used vehicles and items from Public Works, furniture from the Fire-Rescue Department and miscellaneous items from other departments.

### FISCAL IMPACT

Selling the items generates additional revenue for the Town in addition to alleviating space concerns.

### STAFF RECOMMENDATION

The staff recommends that the Board adopt a resolution declaring the attached list of items as surplus property and authorizing the sale of these items at a public auction on October 20, 2007.
