- -Meet for 12-18 months
- -review in turn each of 6 topics:
  - √ Think Local First
  - Identifying & Plugging Leaks
  - Mobilize Small Businesses
  - **Entrepreneurship Training**
  - **Investor Mobilization**
  - Public Policy Reform
- -Suggested: use Small-Mart Revolution "check-lists" as they provide @ 100 action items for initial consideration, supplement with research on effective strategies used elsewhere;
- -Recommended general process: discuss, identify best fits for Carrboro, consider broad implementation strategies, prioritize;
- -report to BOA as discussion on each topic area is completed with recommendations on possible short term action plan for that area;
- -use final meetings to develop an integrated implementation strategy
- -develop mechanisms during that time frame for engaging business and public as relevant to topics;
- -develop a Local Living Economy kick-off event e.g. Carrboro Think Local First Festival (possibly both a celebration of Carrboro economy plus workshops/plenaries on moving forward with the Local Living Economy);
