**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TOWN CODE TO REMOVE THE REQUIREMENTS
FOR A PUBLIC HEARING BEFORE CLOSING THE STREET FOR THE ANNUAL
FRANGELISM IN THE PARK EVENT**

THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN FOR THE TOWN OF CARRBORO ORDAINS:

Section 1. Subsection 7-19(c) of the Carrboro Town Code is amended to read as follows:

(c) The Board finds that the annual Christmas parade sponsored by the Chapel Hill-Carrboro Chamber of Commerce, the Fourth of July Celebration sponsored by the Town of Carrboro, the Carrboro Day celebration sponsored by the Town of Carrboro, the Carrboro Music Festival sponsored by the Town of Carrboro, the Four on the Fourth road Race, the Carrboro 10K Road Race, and the Gallop and Gorge Road Race sponsored by the Cardinal Track Club, and the Frangelism in the Park event sponsored by St. Joseph AME Church have become established traditions that are expected and anticipated by those whose properties or businesses are affected by them and that are well publicized apart from the public hearing procedures set forth in this article. Therefore, the annual Christmas parade, the Fourth of July celebration, the Carrboro Day celebration, the Carrboro music Festival, the Four on the Fourth road Race, Carrboro 10K road Race, the Gallop and Gorge Road Race, and Frangelism in the Park are exempt from the requirements of this section. Section 2. All provisions of any town ordinance in conflict with this ordinance are repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSING AND USAGE OF
BROAD STREET BETWEEN FOWLER AND HILL STREETS TO
ACCOMMODATE THE FRANGELISM IN THE PARK EVENT
Resolution No. 10/2008-09**

Section 1. The following street shall be temporarily closed and used Saturday, September, 13th 2008 from 7:30 am to 4:00 pm to accommodate the Frangelism in the Park Event:

Broad Street, between Fowler and Hill Street

Section 2. This event is to be held in accordance with the permit issued by the Board of Aldermen pursuant to Article III of Chapter 7 of the Town.

Section 3. The Town shall supply the appropriate traffic control devices to give notice of the temporary traffic controls.

Section 4. No person may operate any vehicle contrary to the traffic control devices installed in accordance with Section 3 of this resolution.

Section 5. The Event Coordinator will be responsible for notifying Central Communications when the street is closed and when it is reopened to vehicular traffic.

Section 6. Applicant shall distribute flyers of notification, to persons occupying property abutting the streets where the event is to take place, of the contents of any resolution passed.

Section 7. Applicant will be responsible for all costs incurred by the Public Works Department to facilitate this event. Applicant will be sent an itemized bill for the final costs incurred by Public Works.

Section 8. This resolution shall become effective upon adoption.

NOTIFICATION OF CENTRAL COMMUNICATIONS (911):

The **APPLICANT** is responsible for notifying Central Communications (911):

- at least five (5) days in advance of the event in writing (Orange County EMS, Post Office Box 8181, Hillsborough, NC 27278)
- on the day of the closing, prior to the actual closing of the street (dialing 911)
- on the day of the closing, when the street is re-opened (dialing 911)

NOTIFICATION OF THE PUBLIC:

A public hearing is required for all street closing permit applications and the applicant must speak with the Town Clerk about requesting this public hearing. The public must be notified by a formal advertisement in a local newspaper. The Public Works Department will submit the advertisement copy to the newspaper. **However, the applicant will be responsible for reimbursing the Town for the full cost of the advertisement (an estimated \$30-\$40).**

Any other notification of the public of this event will be the Applicant's responsibility.

NOTIFICATION OF ABUTTING PROPERTY OWNERS:

The **APPLICANT** is responsible for notifying all abutting property owners of the Public Hearing. Such notification must be accomplished at least seven days prior to the Public Hearing. The notification must include:

- the DATE, TIME and LOCATION of the proposed street closing; and
- the DATE, TIME and LOCATION of the Public Hearing as well as the subject matter of this Public Hearing

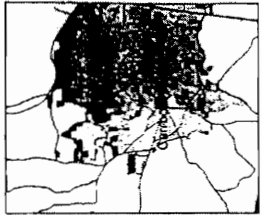
The Public Works Department must receive in writing from the **APPLICANT** the following at least five days prior to the Public Hearing:

- names of all property owners notified
- copy of the notification
- method used to notify these property owners (mail or hand delivery)
