PURPOSE

The purpose of item is to provide a follow-up report to the Carrboro Board of Aldermen on the Limited Anti-Lingering Ordinance approved by the Board on November 20, 2007.

INFORMATION

The Board of Aldermen approved an anti-lingering ordinance to address a problem at Davie and Jones Ferry Road. The problems were brought to the attention of the Town by residents of the Davie Road, Glosson Circle and Alabama Avenue neighborhood. The elements of the ordinance clearly prescribed actions that should take place to limit the time that day laborers may wait for work at the corner and other issues that potentially posed health and safety issues for the public.

As indicated by the attached memo, the anti-lingering ordinance achieved the desired results. The findings of this report come from staff observation of the area by various Town of Carrboro Departments, interaction with the day labor population, communication with El Centro, and through contact with concerned neighbors.
