**TITLE: A Resolution Designating a Local Official to Make Recommendations to the North Carolina Alcoholic Beverage Control Commission on ABC Permit Applications**

#### PURPOSE

The Board of Aldermen is requested to adopt a resolution designating the Chief of Police and Police Captain as the officials empowered to make recommendations to the North Carolina Alcoholic Beverage Control Commission regarding alcoholic beverage permits.

#### INFORMATION

NC General Statute 18B-904(f) allows for local governments to make recommendations regarding the suitability of ABC Permit applications. The North Carolina Alcoholic Beverage Control Commission considers the opinion of a local government designee before issuing an alcoholic beverage permit.

Currently, Carrboro's designee is listed as former Police Chief Ben Callahan. An ABC Commission staffer has provided the Police Department with a template for the resolution which is required to update the designee information. The staffer also clarified that two officials may be designated and that they may be listed solely by position.

The Police Department wishes to name the Chief of Police and Police Captain as the designated officials.
