

A RESOLUTION SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING ON A REVISED DESIGN FOR
SMITH LEVEL ROAD IMPROVEMENTS
Resolution No. 124/2009-10

WHEREAS, planning activities related to improvements to Smith Level Road in Carrboro have occurred since the 1980s; and

WHEREAS, the Smith Level Road Task Force submitted a report to the Board of Aldermen in 2007 making various recommendations for road improvements; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Carrboro *Comprehensive Bicycle Transportation Plan* recommends as a top priority bicycle lanes along both sides of Smith Level Road; and

WHEREAS, under Transportation Improvement Program project #U-2803, the North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) has proposed a revised design for improvements to Smith Level Road from the Town limits south of Woodcrest Drive to the Morgan Creek bridge;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Carrboro Board of Aldermen that the Board of Aldermen calls a public hearing for April 27, 2010, at 7:30pm, to consider the revised design for improvements to Smith Level Road.

The public hearing shall be preceded by a one-hour public information session (6:30-7:30pm) in Carrboro Town Hall to allow for the public to review the revised design.
