PURPOSE

The purpose of this agenda item is to facilitate a discussion of legislative issues to present to our local delegation at the upcoming legislative breakfast scheduled for Monday, April 12, 2009 at 7:30 a.m. in Town Hall. The delegation may be able to pursue some of the issues presented during the upcoming session of the NC General Assembly.

INFORMATION

In previous years, the Board of Aldermen has developed a package of legislative issues to discuss with the delegation. Occasionally, this package has included a piece of local legislation that the Board of Alderman would like to get passed.

Alderman Slade requested information related to Property Assessed Clean Energy (PACE) Bonds. Staff has attached information related to that program. The Town Attorney has advised staff that PACE bonds would require general legislation to enact, as opposed to special legislation applicable only to the Town of Carrboro.
