

A RESOLUTION REGARDING A PETITION RELATED TO THE TOWN'S EXTRA-
TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION
Resolution No. 137/2009-10

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen received a petition dated October 27, 2009 from landowners requesting that the Town "relinquish control over ETJ [extraterritorial jurisdiction] land and return development jurisdiction for it to Orange County government as soon as possible; and

WHEREAS, several residents of Carrboro's ETJ appeared before the Orange County Board of County Commissioners (OCBOCC) and requested that the County Commissioners unilaterally remove regulatory authority over farms within Carrboro's ETJ based on North Carolina General Statute 160A-360(g); and

WHEREAS, in follow-up communication with Town Attorney, Michael B. Brough, Roberts has indicated that the OCBOCC wish to know whether the Town would be interested in relinquishing control over those properties in the ETJ used for farming, rather than the entire ETJ; and

WHEREAS, 11 of the 36 petitioners, reside on and/or own eight properties located in Carrboro's ETJ; five of those properties are in agricultural use value for tax purposes; and

WHEREAS, Orange County's attorney, John L. Roberts, has requested information on the Mayor and Board of Aldermen's position on relinquishing control and land use regulatory authority of farms within Carrboro's ETJ and the Town's position statement regarding the applicability of NCGS 160A-360 (g), 160A-360(h) or some other statutory or case law; and

WHEREAS, since Carrboro's ETJ was created by special legislation (Chapters 122 and 636 of Session Laws of 1963) and not pursuant to NCGS 160A, while Carrboro and Orange County could mutually agree to change the ETJ boundary, the County could not act unilaterally do so; and

WHEREAS, the Carrboro Board of Aldermen has considered the County's request.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF CARRBORO:

Dear Mr. Stewart:

I am writing to request information regarding the position of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen on relinquishing control and land use regulatory authority of farms within Carrboro's Extra Territorial Jurisdiction ("ETJ") to Orange County.

The reason for this inquiry is the recent appearance at an Orange County Board of Commissioners meeting of several residents of Carrboro's ETJ who requested the County Commissioners unilaterally remove regulatory authority over farms within Carrboro's ETJ and restore that authority to Orange County. These residents based their request on North Carolina General Statute 160A-360(g), which allows a government that granted another government ETJ authority to withdraw that authority upon two years' notice. Therefore, I would also request a position statement from the Town on whether 160A-360(g) applies to Carrboro and its ETJ or whether 160A-360(h) is the more applicable section. If some other statutory or case law applies to Carrboro in this situation please direct me to that law.

This inquiry should not be interpreted as a formal request that Carrboro relinquish regulatory control and authority to Orange County. It simply reflects an interest in knowing the official position of the Town and its elected officials.

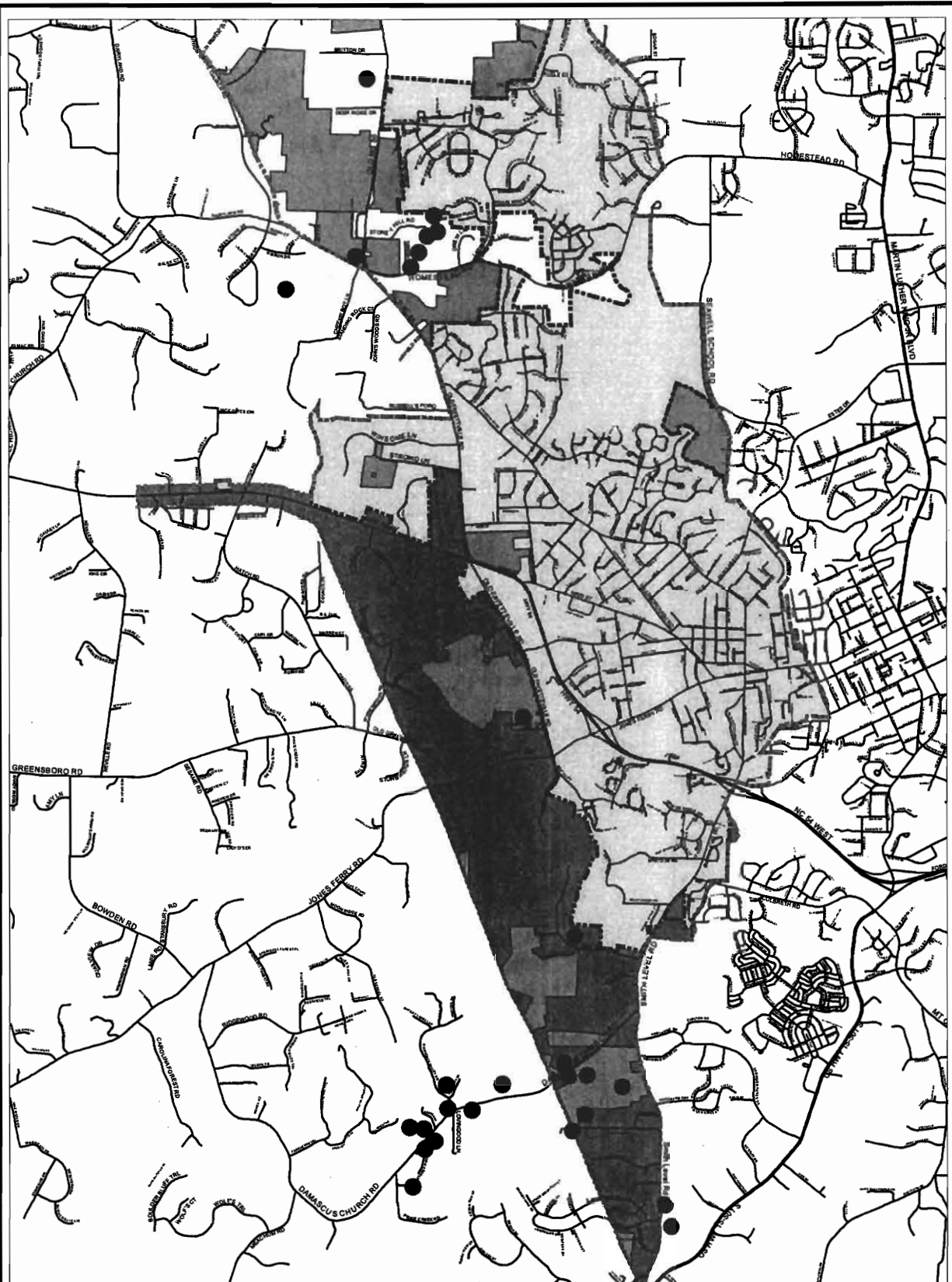

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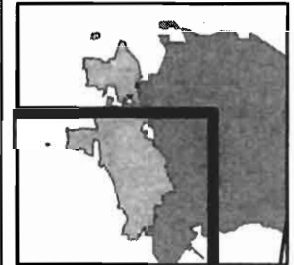
