PURPOSE

The group Connect Carrboro has requested the Board's consideration of the attached resolution supporting inclusion of Carrboro in the Triangle Regional Transit Program Alternatives Analysis process, which is now underway.

INFORMATION

At the June 15 Board of Aldermen meeting, a group of citizens representing Connect Carrboro requested that the Board consider the resolution in *Attachment A* supporting inclusion of Carrboro in the Triangle Regional Transit Program Alternatives Analysis process being conducted by Triangle Transit to determine the feasibility of regional light rail transit and other regional transportation modes. The Board referred the resolution to the Transportation Advisory Board. The TAB reviewed the resolution on June 17 and approved the recommendation in *Attachment B*, which recommended an addition to the resolution stating that at least one public meeting should be held in Carrboro.
