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### **PURPOSE**

The Town staff has prepared an amendment to Section 6-19 of the Town Code related to parking along Renee Lynne Ct. Staff recommends that the Board of Aldermen adopt the ordinance amending the Town Code.

#### **INFORMATION**

The special use permit for the Rock Haven Center on Renee Lynne Ct., approved in 2000, designates Renee Lynne Ct. as a fire lane and prohibits on-street parking. Approved construction plans include notes requiring the installation of "No Parking" signs and pavement striping in compliance with the Carrboro Fire Marshal. The 2009 N.C. Fire Code, Sec. 503.2, establishes a minimum fire apparatus clearance width of 20 ft. and empowers fire code officials to determine required turning radii for a fire apparatus. The current width of Renee Lynne Ct. is 24 ft. curb-to-curb. If on-street parking were allowed with dimensions required by LUO Sec. 15-293, the 9.5-ft. width would narrow the street such that it would fail to comply with the fire apparatus clearance standard. An on-street parking prohibition is therefore needed to provide an adequate level of accessibility for EMS/Fire Department in emergency situations. This amendment is being prepared to formalize the parking prohibition in the Town Code.

The amendment (*Attachment A*) was originally scheduled for the June 15, 2010, Board of Aldermen meeting. Prior to this meeting, letters were sent to neighboring property owners informing them of the proposal. The agenda item was delayed in order to provide more information to, and receive feedback from, a property owner. On July 12, 2010, Town staff discussed the item via the staff-level Traffic and Parking Committee, which affirmed the recommendation to prohibit parking based on the reasons described above. This information was shared with the property owner, who may request additional review of the matter.

Parking limitations are listed in Section 6-19 of the Town Code. *Attachment B* is an excerpt of Sec. 6-19(b)(1). *Attachment C* is a map of the Renee Lynne Ct. area.

## **FISCAL IMPACT**

Signage has already been installed. Some additional staff time should be expected associated with enforcement of the new parking limitations.

## **RECOMMENDATION**

Staff recommends that the Board of Aldermen adopt the ordinance amending the Town Code (*Attachment A*).
