

A RESOLUTION CONTINUING A PUBLIC HEARING ON A LAND USE  
ORDINANCE TEXT AMENDMENT RELATED TO MINIMUM LOT WIDTHS  
Resolution No. 15/2010-11

WHEREAS, the Carrboro Board of Aldermen seeks to provide ample opportunities for the public to consider modifications to existing policies and regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen held a public hearing on June 22, 2010 to consider adopting "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING MISCELLANEOUS REQUIREMENTS OF THE CARRBORO LAND USE ORDINANCE BY REVISING THE LIST OF INVASIVE PLANT SPECIES, ESTABLISHING REGULATIONS FOR ELECTRONIC GAMING OPERATIONS, AND MODIFYING PROVISIONS ASSOCIATED WITH MINOR SUBDIVISIONS, PERFORMANCE GUARANTEES, STORM WATER MANAGEMENT, AND MINIMUM LOT WIDTHS;" and

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen adopted all but Section 9 of the draft ordinance, continued the public hearing on that section to September 28<sup>th</sup>, and requested additional information; and

WHEREAS, staff is compiling additional information and requests the hearing be continued to October 26th to complete that task.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the public hearing on the draft ordinance provision related to minimum lot widths is hereby continued to October 26, 2010.
