2010 RECREATIONAL TRAILS PROGRAM GRANT PROJECT ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Town of Carrboro, through the Recreations and Parks Department, has been awarded a Recreational Trails Program Grant by the North Carolina Department of Environmental and Natural Resources (NCDENR) to support the constructions of the Wilson Park Multi-Use Path; and,

WHEREAS, the grant must be used to support the construction of the Wilson Park Multi-Use Path; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen for the Town of Carrboro deems this activity to be a worthy and desirable undertaking:

NOW, THEREFORE PURSUANT TO N.C.G.S 159-13.2, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF CARRBORO THAT:

- 1. The grant project is authorized to support the construction of the Wilson Park Multi-Use Path and is hereby authorized to be undertaken until all project activity is completed.
- 2. The following revenues are anticipated to be available to the Town of Carrboro to complete this project:

Matching Funds by Town-Bond Fund	\$18,751.20
Total	\$93,751.20

3. The following amount is appropriated for this project to be expended in the following manner:

Trail Grading	\$ 6,890.40
Asphalt Path	\$73,080.00
Gravel Shoulder	\$13,780.80
Total Appropriation	\$93,751.20

4. Within five (5) days after this ordinance is adopted, the Town Clerk shall file a copy of this ordinance with the Finance Director.
