2010 PHYSICAL ACTIVITY IN THE BUILT ENVIRONMENT GRANT PROJECT ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Town of Carrboro, through the Planning Department, has been awarded a Physical Activity in the Built Environment grant by the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services (NCDHHS), Division of Public Health to encourage physical activity and active lifestyles; and,

WHEREAS, the grant must be used to plan policies and strategies to encourage physical activity and active lifestyles; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen for the Town of Carrboro deems this activity to be a worthy and desirable undertaking:

NOW, THEREFORE PURSUANT TO N.C.G.S 159-13.2, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF CARRBORO THAT:

- 1. The grant project is authorized to support activities that identify policy barriers to physical activity and a transportation system that encourages active lifestyles and is hereby authorized to be undertaken until all project activity is completed.
- 2. The Town Manager is authorized to execute the grant agreement and other documents that are required or appropriate in order for the Town to receive the grant and undertake this project.
- 3. The following revenues are anticipated to be available to the Town of Carrboro to complete this project:
