

2010 SECTION 319 WATERSHED RESTORATION GRANT PROJECT ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Town of Carrboro, through the Planning Department, has been awarded a Section 319 NPS Pollution Control Grant by the North Carolina Department of Environmental and Natural Resources (NCDENR) to support the continuation of a multi-year watershed restoration efforts for Bolin Creek; and,

WHEREAS, the grant is a cooperative effort between the Town of Carrboro, North Carolina State University, Chapel Hill-Carrboro School system, and Friends of Bolin Creek; and,

WHEREAS, the grant requires in-kind and cash matching contributions to support the project; and,

WHEREAS, the grant must be used to support continued watershed restoration efforts for Bolin Creek; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen for the Town of Carrboro previously authorized the submission of a grant application to continue watershed restoration efforts in Bolin Creek and deems this activity to be a worthy and desirable undertaking:

NOW, THEREFORE PURSUANT TO N.C.G.S 159-13.2, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF CARRBORO THAT:

1. The grant project is authorized to support the continuation of watershed restoration efforts for Bolin Creek and is hereby authorized to be undertaken until all project activity is completed.
2. The following revenues are anticipated to be available to the Town of Carrboro to complete this project:

In-Kind Match	\$148,393.00
Cash Match - Friends of Bolin Creek	<u>\$ 5,000.00</u>
Total	\$353,393.00

3. The following amount is appropriated for this project to be expended in the following manner:

Personnel	\$ 54,643.00
Contractual	\$270,000.00
Travel and Other	<u>\$ 28,750.00</u>
Total Appropriation	\$353,393.00

4. Within five (5) days after this ordinance is adopted, the Town Clerk shall file a copy of this ordinance with the Finance Director.
