

Safe Routes to School Non-Infrastructure Grant Project Ordinance

WHEREAS, the Town of Carrboro, through the Planning Department, has been awarded a Safe Routes to School Non-Infrastructure Grant Project Ordinance to support educational and encouragement program activities at Carrboro Elementary School to support walking and bicycling to school; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen for the Town of Carrboro deems this activity to be a worthy and desirable undertaking:

NOW, THEREFORE PURSUANT TO N.C.G.S 159-13.2, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF CARRBORO THAT:

1. The grant project is authorized for educational and encouragement program activities at Carrboro Elementary School to support walking and bicycling to school and is hereby authorized to be undertaken until all project activity is completed.
2. The following revenues are anticipated to be available to the Town of Carrboro to complete this project:
