# **PURPOSE**

The purpose of this item is for the Board to receive proposals from firms that could assist in the recruitment and selection process for the position Town Manager.

### **INFORMATION**

The Board requested that staff publish an RFP for search firms that could assist in the recruitment and selection process for Town Manager. Town staff has received proposals from the following four firms:

- 1) Developmental Associates
- 2) The Mercer Group, Inc.
- 3) Slavin Management Group
- 4) Springsted, Inc.

Upon request, the firms will provide additional information to the Board. If the Board interviews one or more firms, a special meeting may need to be scheduled based upon the availability of the Board and the availability of the firm(s).

If the Board awards a contract in FY 2010-2011, a budget amendment will be need to be approved at the June 28, 2011 Board meeting. As the Board knows, the fee is only one part of what should be considered

in the decision. This is not a competitive bid situation, so the Board can select the firm it feels best meets its needs in the recruitment process even if the fee is not the lowest.

Additional staff time will be required if staff is asked to make interview arrangements, or to provide additional follow-up.

# **RECOMMENDATION**
