

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TOWN CODE TO MODIFY THE PROVISIONS
RELATED TO THE GREENWAYS COMMISSION

THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF CARRBORO ORDAINS:

Section 1. Article V of Chapter 3 of the Carrboro Town code is amended by revising Subsection 3-24.7 (a) to read as follows:

Section 3-24.7. Greenways Commission Created

- (a) There shall be a Greenways Commission composed of 11-12 voting members appointed by the Board of Aldermen. The Board shall endeavor to appoint members such that the membership of the commission will include at least four residents of the town and at least ~~four~~ *six* representatives of the community at large,
- Planning Board (1 seat)
 - Recreation and Parks Commission (1 seat)
 - Environmental Advisory Board (1 seat)
 - Transportation Advisory Board (1 seat)
 - At-large representatives (*6* seats)
 - ~~Morgan Creek Valley Alliance (1 seat)~~
 - ~~Friends of Bolin Creek (1 seat)~~
 - Board of Aldermen Liaison (1-2 seats)

Section 2. All provisions of any town ordinance in conflict with this ordinance are repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.

Section 3-24.7. Greenways Commission Created (Amend. 6/26/07, 10/2/07, 3/16/10)

(a) There shall be a Greenways Commission composed of 11-12 voting members appointed by the Board of Aldermen. The Board shall endeavor to appoint members such that the membership of the commission will include at least four residents of the town and at least four representatives of the community at large,

- Planning Board (1 seat)
- Recreation and Parks Commission (1 seat)
- Environmental Advisory Board (1 seat)
- Transportation Advisory Board (1 seat)
- At-large representatives (4 seats)
- Morgan Creek Valley Alliance (1 seat)
- Friends of Bolin Creek (1 seat)
- Board of Aldermen Liaison (1-2 seats)

TOWN CODE AMENDMENT REVISING THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE GREENWAYS COMMISSION (ITEM C(4))

This agenda item serves to update the Town Code provisions related to the membership structure of the Greenways Commission.

Mayor Chilton expressed his interest in serving as a member of the Greenways Commission and asked that the proposed amendment be revised to state that there will be 1 - 2 Board of Aldermen representatives on the Commission.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TOWN CODE TO MODIFY THE PROVISIONS
RELATED TO THE GREENWAYS COMMISSION
Ordinance No. 20/2009-10

THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF CARRBORO ORDAINS:

Section 1. Article V of Chapter 3 of the Carrboro Town code is amended by revising Subsections 3-24.7 (a) and (e) to read as follows:

Section 3-24.7. Greenways Commission Created

- (a) There shall be a Greenways Commission composed of 11-12 voting members appointed by the Board of Aldermen. The Board shall endeavor to appoint members such that the membership of the commission will include at least four residents of the town and at least four representatives of the community at large,
- Planning Board (1 seat)
 - Recreation and Parks Commission (1 seat)
 - Environmental Advisory Board (1 seat)
 - Transportation Advisory Board (1 seat)
 - At-large representatives (4 seats)
 - Morgan Creek Valley Alliance (1 seat)
 - Friends of Bolin Creek (1 seat)
 - Board of Aldermen Liaison (1-2 seats)

(e) The liaison member(s) shall serve at the pleasure of the Board. Other members may be removed as follows:

- (1) The chairman shall file or cause to be filed with the town clerk an attendance report from time-to-time identifying those members who were present or absent.
- (2) Unless the chairman waives the requirement, members shall be removed if they are absent from three consecutive meetings or if they miss more than thirty percent of the meetings during a twelve month period. The Town Clerk shall notify the chairman in writing as soon as a member becomes subject to removal under this section. The chairman will have ten days after receipt of such notice to waive the removal. If the chairman fails to notify the Town Clerk in writing within ten days after receipt of such notice that the automatic removal requirement should be waived, the Town Clerk will send a removal notice to the member. This removal shall be effective on the date of such notice.
- (3) Members may also be removed by the appointing authority, after a hearing, for any good cause related to performance of duty.

Section 2. Article V of Chapter 3 of the Carrboro Town code is amended by revising Subsection 3-24.8 (b) to read as follows:

Section 3-24.8 Meetings and Officers of Greenways Commission

(b) A quorum for the commission shall consist of six members, except that if there are two or more vacant seats, a quorum shall consist of five members. All actions of the commission shall be taken by majority vote of those present and voting, a quorum being present.

Section 3. All provisions of any town ordinance in conflict with this ordinance are repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.
