PURPOSE

The Board of Aldermen is asked to consider approval of a Supplemental Agreement with NCDOT to extend the timeline of the Municipal Agreement, approved by the Board of Aldermen on May 18, 2010, to December 31, 2011.

INFORMATION

The only change being made by the Supplemental Agreement is the extension of the Agreement to the end of 2011. This will allow for additional programming at Carrboro Elementary in the Fall of 2011, including a Walk/Bike to School Day event similar to last year's. This extension has been preliminarily accepted by the NCDOT Safe Routes to School Coordinator.

FISCAL AND STAFF IMPACT

The total grant amount is \$12,864, with 100 percent of the funding coming from federal Safe Routes to School funds from FHWA, administered by NCDOT. (NCDOT is able to provide technical oversight as part of the project.)
