A RESOLUTION APPROVING A SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE NORTH
CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE WILSON PARK MULTI-
USE PATH

WHEREAS, the Town of Carrboro has received authorization from the Federal Highway Administration and North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) to construct the Wilson Park Multi-use Path (NCDOT TIP #U-4726-DC); and,

WHEREAS, the current Municipal Agreement's milestone date for completion of the project is April 30, 2012; and,

WHEREAS, more time will be needed to complete the project, due to delays associated with NCDOT guidance and the need to re-advertise the project for construction bids and subsequently Town staff requested an extension of time for completion;

WHEREAS, NCDOT has granted an extension of time to December 31, 2012 in a Supplemental Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Carrboro Board of Aldermen that the Board approves the Supplemental Agreement with NCDOT extending the completion date to December 31, 2012.
