AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CARRBORO TOWN CODE TO PROVIDE THAT ONLY RESIDENTS OF THE TOWN OF CARRBORO MAY BE APPOINTED OR REAPPOINTED TO SERVE ON THE GREENWAYS COMMISSION

THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF CARRBORO ORDAINS:

Section 1. Subsection 3-24.7(a) of the Carrboro Town Code

- (a) There shall be a Greenways Commission composed of one or two members of the Board of Aldermen appointed by the Board as liaison members, plus six other members appointed by the Board of Aldermen. All persons appointed or reappointed to the Commission after the effective date of this subsection shall be residents of the Town, and residency within the Town shall be a continuing requirement for membership on the Commission. However, any member of the Commission who does not reside within the Town on the effective date of the amendment to this subsection shall be allowed to remain as a member of the Commission until that member's term expires and a successor has been appointed and qualifies.
- Section 2. All provisions of any town ordinance in conflict with this ordinance are repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.
