A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE A CONTRACT FOR ANIMAL CONTROL SERVICES WITH ORANGE COUNTY Draft Resolution No. 98/2012-13

WHEREAS, the Town of Carrboro has adopted certain animal control ordinances; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to ensure compliance with animal control ordinances for the safety and well- being of citizens and the community; and

WHEREAS, animal control enforcement is currently provided by Town police officers and administrative police personnel, resulting in a reduction of time for other public safety and law enforcement duties and responsibilities; and

WHEREAS, the Orange County Animal Services Department has indicated a desire to provide animal control services and outreach activities for the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen believes a contract with the Orange County Animal Services Department may be beneficial to the Town;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Carrboro Board of Aldermen authorizes the Town Manager to negotiate and enter into a services contract with Orange County for animal control services and other activities provided that such contract maintains the current level of animal control services and provides for more improved services in the Town.
