CALVANDER INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS

Linda Roberts expressed concern about comments made at last week's Board of Aldermen meeting relating to a meeting with N.C. DOT representatives, members of the Board of Aldermen and Calvander residents. Ms. Roberts stated that the town staff has a mission statement which states that the town staff shall treat citizens with respect. Ms. Roberts asked for a public apology for comments made at last week's meeting. Ms. Roberts requested that the Board wait until the Small Area Plan is approved before the Calvander improvements are made.

PUBLIC HEARING/LAND USE ORDINANCE TEXT AMENDMENT INCREASING DISTANCE OF HEARING NOTICE GIVEN TO PROPERTY OWNERS FOR CONDITIONAL USE PERMITS AND MAP AMENDMENTS The purpose of this item was for the Mayor and Board of Aldermen to hold a public hearing to receive citizens' comments on a proposed amendment to the Land Use Ordinance increasing the distance for written notification given to property owners of public hearings on applications for conditional use permits and zoning map amendments.

Lisa Bloom-Pruitt, the town's Senior Planner, briefly explained the proposed amendment.

Andy Cohen, Chair of the Planning Board, stated that the Planning Board suggested that informational meetings be required in addition to increasing the notification distance. The Planning Board also felt that developers be required to verify property owners with a fine to ensure correctness.

Ellen Perry requested that notices of public hearings be placed on the community bulletin board station.

MOTION WAS MADE BY HANK ANDERSON TO ADOPT THE ORDINANCE ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CARRBORO LAND USE ORDINANCE TO CHANGE THE NOTIFICATION DISTANCE OF PROPERTY OWNERS FROM 200 FEET TO 500 FEET FOR CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT AND MAP AMENDMENTS". MOTION DIED FOR THE LACK OF A SECOND.

MOTION WAS MADE BY JAY BRYAN AND SECONDED BY JACQUELYN GIST TO ADOPT THE ORDINANCE ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CARRBORO LAND USE ORDINANCE TO CHANGE THE NOTIFICATION DISTANCE OF PROPERTY OWNERS FROM 200 FEET TO 1,000 FEET FOR CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT AND MAP AMENDMENTS" BE ADOPTED. VOTE: AFFIRMATIVE SIX, NEGATIVE ONE

MOTION WAS MADE BY ALEX ZAFFRON AND SECONDED BY DIANA MCDUFFEE TO REQUEST THAT THE TOWN STAFF SUBMIT NOTICES OF PUBLIC HEARINGS FOR CONDITIONAL USE PERMITS AND ZONING AMENDMENTS TO TIME WARNER FOR PLACEMENT ON THE COMMUNITY BULLETIN BOARD STATION AT THE SAME TIME THEY ARE SUBMITTED FOR PUBLICATION IN THE NEWSPAPER. VOTE: AFFIRMATIVE ALL

It was the consensus of the Board to request that developers meet with neighbors up to 1,000 feet of the property in question.

PUBLIC HEARING/LAND USE ORDINANCE TEXT AMENDMENT/RETAIL SALES WITH SUBORDINATE MANUFACTURING AND PROCESSING

The purpose of this item was for the Mayor and Board of Aldermen to hold a public hearing and receive comment on possible revisions to the Land Use Ordinance which would add a classification of permissible uses under the 2.000 classification for retail sales establishments that include manufacturing of the products subordinate to selling them on premises.

Lisa Bloom-Pruitt, the town's Senior Planner, explained the proposed amendment.

Andy Cohen, Chair of the Planning Board, stated that the Planning Board had concern about the uncertainty of what type business could be included within this classification.

A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE TOWN OF CHAPEL HILL AS THE LEAD AGENCY FOR THE PREPARATION OF THE STATE PLAN FOR ORANGE COUNTY, CARRBORO AND CHAPEL HILL, AND ENABLING THE TOWN OF CHAPEL HILL'S SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT STAFF TO MAKE REQUESTS OF AND COORDINATE WITH LOCAL GOVERNMENT STAFFS FOR INFORMATION NECESSARY TO COMPLETE THE STATE PLAN Resolution No. 47/96-97

WHEREAS, the State of North Carolina requires that local governments submit a solid waste management plan by July 1, 1997; and

WHEREAS, the State of North Carolina encourages submission of regional plans by cooperating jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, the Orange Regional Landfill Owners' Group has already engaged in a joint planning process for integrated solid waste management that involves all four governments within the County; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Chapel Hill's Solid Waste Management Department has already acted as staff for that study and gathered much of the information that would be required in the State Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Chapel Hill's Solid Waste Management Department has acted as lead staff for most solid waste planning efforts in Orange County;

NOW, THEREFORE THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF CARRBORO RESOLVES:

Section 1. The Town of Carrboro hereby acknowledges the Town of Chapel Hill as the lead agency for the development of our State Solid Waste Plan;

Section 2. The Town of Carrboro hereby authorizes the Town's staff to work directly with the Town of Chapel Hill's staff to gather the information necessary to complete the State solid waste plan.
